Roedd pwyslais ar yr angen i rhoi datganiadau o ddiddordeb ac hefyd i defnyddio a gofyn am ollyngiadau./ The need to provide declarations of interests were stressed and also the appropriateness for dispensations requests featured highly during the session.

Members should take time to familiarise, themselves with the code and always have regard to it when conducting council business .

2. Yn dilyn gofyniad wrth y Pwyllgor safonau am wybodaeth am ddatganiadau a dderbyniwyd wrth aelodau y cyngor dywedodd y clercc ei fod wedi danfon y wybodaeth. / following a request from the Standards Committee for the number of declarations made by members of the community council , the clerk informed that he had sent all the information requested

3. Roedd y clercc wedi danfon gwybodaeth llawn o adroddiad Ariannol diwedd y flwyddyn 2014/15 at yr archwilwyr allanol BDO Stoy . / The clerk had sent the full information regarding the end of year financial report requested for 2014/15 to the external Auditors BDO Stoy

4. Dywedodd y clercc ei fod wedi derbyn disgrifiad swydd a hysbyseb swydd wrth Un Llais Cymru .Bydd angen i'r Is Bwyllgor gwrdd cyn gynted a phosibl i drafod y mater.

The clerk informed that he had received a template job description and job advert from One Voice Wales ,which will need to be discussed with the sub committee as soon as possible.

5. Cyfarfod cysylltu Cyngorau Tref a Cymuned / Town and community council liaison meeting.

Derbyniwyd adroddiad wrth y Cynng Robert Jones a welir isod / A report was received from Cllr Robert Jones as shown below :-

- The meeting was attended by new county council leader, Emlyn Dole, and 2 deputies. Presentation on community resilience with regard to planning for any major emergencies within the county. major emergencies are those that pose a threat of serious damage to a large area or that could result in a large number of human casualties and would/could involve the services of police/fire/ambulance/military/local authority. Different communities will have different types of threat eg. flooding, fire, etc. Communities should plan and liaise with county council if specific threats are identified. New web page set up on county council website. Carms has 30 emergency centres retained for use if necessary.
- Talk on the plan to develop affordable housing. Need to substantially increase the number of affordable homes with various factors leading to the current shortfall. 7500 people on waiting list. Demand outstripping supply. Currently short of 1850 homes per year for the next 5 years. Last year only 40 affordable homes built. Consultation on how to address the gap has just finished and a development plan will be presented to the county in the autumn.
- AOB - statement from the floor regarding one of the detrimental consequences (financial implications to residents) of the recent Local Government White Paper. Del Morgan asked why the subject of planning notifications (as brought up at the recent One Voice Wales area board meeting by HVW, Llanddarog CC) hadn't been addressed at the meeting, to which the chair replied that she had removed it from the agenda because no substantive response had been received from the county planning dept.

2. Lowri Harris Cadeirydd / Chairman ' Pwyllgor Cylch Meithrin

She informs that in the last report from Estyn they received a report stating that they were providing a good standard of education to the children . In order to provide opportunities for a higher standard there is a need to create an external multisensory garden for children with learning difficulties and any funding will be used for this purpose . Penderfynwyd rhoi £50 tuag at y costau / It was agreed to give £50 towards the cost.

3. Stratus Environmental yn danfon gwybodaeth am eu cais i rhoi fferm solar ar 12 erw o ddaear rhwng Heol Cefneithin a Foelgastell ar y Brif Ffordd . Bydd y safle yn gallu rhoi 5MW o ynni sydd yn ddigon i rhoi trydan i 1553 o dai. / writes to the council to inform of their application for a solar farm on a site located to the West of Cefneithin covering 12 acres. The site lies between the Cefneithin to Foelgastell Rd and the Dual Carriageway . The site will be capable of generating 5MW of energy which is enough to supply 1553 homes.

2. STATUTORY GUIDANCE ON THE ACCESS TO INFORMATION , LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DEMOCRACY) (WALES) ACT 2013

I am writing to advise you that following discussions with the Welsh Government it has become clear that the new responsibility for publishing the register of interests on-line does not require the completion of the form that we circulated to you last week.

We had initially thought that the exemption for community and town councillors from the requirements of paragraph 15(1) of the model code of conduct to register certain financial and other interests within 28 days of taking up office had been removed by the 2013 Act. However, following discussion with the relevant Welsh Government policy official this is not the case. He is aware that there may well have been confusion on this point and has confirmed that the 2013 Act has no impact on the requirements of the code of conduct relating to the disclosure and registration of interests. In summary, the requirements of the code of conduct, as it applies to community and town councils, are as follows:-

- a) Councillors are required to declare a personal and, if appropriate, prejudicial interest in relation to pertinent matters when they are present at meetings.
- b) When Councillors disclose a personal interest for the first time, they must give written confirmation of the interest to the Proper Officer, before or immediately after the close of the meeting.
Although not a requirement of the code, it is good practice for the Proper Officer to record these declarations in the minutes of the meeting.
- c) The Proper Officer should record interests disclosed at meetings for the first time in the register of interests required under section 81 of the Local

Government Act 2000. The register must be available for public inspection at all reasonable hours and, following commencement of the 2013 Act, must be made available on the council's website.

d) The register should be updated as soon as reasonably practicable after each and every meeting when new interests are disclosed.
