YOUTH AWARD - Criteria and Guidelines.

The aim of the Award: -Is to recognise the achievements of young people or to acknowledge their contribution to the community.

Nominees must be under 25 at the time of nomination and either be :

- Living within the community.
- Working within the community.
- A member of an organisation within the community.

The award is for an individual or groups

- who have achieved or contributed through their skills or abilities in various fields for example education, sports, music, art and culture, agriculture.
- whose efforts have improved or looked after the community's environment, for example by litter picking, enhancing an area or reducing our carbon footprint.
- who have dedicated time to a project which has had a positive impact in the area.
- who go out of their way to help others

Nomination of a person or group for the award is by letter and supporting evidence and can be received from any member of the community.

A group or person is also eligible to nominate themselves.

Nominations to be made in writing. They must be received by 4pm 21 February 2020 by Mr G Evans - The Clerk to the Council, Long Acre, Mynyddcerrig, Llanelli, Carmarthenshire, SA15 5BW. post@ccllanddarog.uk . Nominations will be judged by Members of the community council and their decision will be final
